



Amendment to the Agreement for Academic Cooperation in the Master's Double Degree Program between College of Management, National Sun Yat-sen University and ESSCA School of Management

II. Course Requirements

Participating students shall take courses in English. Special permission is needed for students to take courses other than English from the host institution.

Please see the Appendix for details of the curriculum.

IV. Duration and Fees

Participating students pay tuition fees and other compulsory fees at the home institution, and receive a tuition waiver from the host institution. Students need to pay Computer and Internet Fees of currently NT\$300 per semester at NSYSU.

2. The following details the requirements regulated by ESSCA for NSYSU students to successfully obtain the ESSCA MiM degree.

Applications

NSYSU shall nominate its students to ESSCA before the end of April each year. The candidates should complete an online application, and submit a copy of valid passport, transcripts certified by NSYSU, two recommendation letters and English test result.

Selection Criteria

Students who register for this program are expected to finish the first year of master in the

College of Management, NSYSU and to have high academic quality. Also, students shall have a good command of English. A minimum TOEFL score of iBT 80 (or its equivalent) is required.

Course Requirements

Students will take 2 semesters of courses in MiM and must pass them all. In addition to these courses taken at ESSCA, students should also submit transcript(s) displaying courses successfully completed at NSYSU that can be waived for 60 ECTS credits at ESSCA to satisfy the requirements for the Diploma ESSCA Bac + 5, grade de Master (MiM).

Thesis Requirements

Student shall submit an English thesis supervised by NSYSU to ESSCA. In the case that the thesis is not written in English, student shall submit an English summary of the thesis for at least 10 pages.

Internship

Student must carry out at least a four-month internship during the last year of Master and submit a certificate to ESSCA.

Insurance Fees

All students will be required to provide a certificate of International Insurance, covering medical care and admission to hospital, third party liability and repatriation before arriving in France.
