Enforcement Rules for Tenured Appointments of Full-time Faculty Members

Approved by the 2nd College Faculty Evaluation Committee Meeting on November 21, 2000, School Year 89.

Approved by the 2nd College Faculty Evaluation Committee Meeting on December 27, 2000, School Year 89.

Approved by the 243rd University Faculty Evaluation Committee Meeting on January 15, 2001.

- Article I. This set of enforcement rules is specifically issued in accordance with “National Sun Yat-sen University (NSYSU) Regulations for Tenured Appointments of Faculty Members” and Article II of the “NSYSU Enforcement Rules for Tenured Appointments of Full-time Faculty Members” to set guidelines for tenured appointments of full-time faculty members of the College of Management.
- Article II. The College Faculty Evaluation Committee (hereinafter referred to as the Committee) shall be responsible for second-stage reviews of tenured appointments of faculty members of the college. Committee members who happen to be tenured appointment applicants shall recuse themselves from related discussions and decision-making. If necessary, the committee may appoint additional members.
- Article III. Each department/institute shall establish its own enforcement rules for tenured appointments of full-time faculty members and submit them to be reviewed by the Committee.
- Article IV. The Committee shall complete recommendation work before the end of the first semester. Faculty members recommended may supplement further information.
- Article V. The criteria, point calculation, and terms of tenured appointments of full-time faculty members of the college shall be determined according to the “NSYSU Regulations for Tenured Appointments of Faculty Members” and the “NSYSU Enforcement Rules for Tenured Appointments of Full-time Faculty Members.”
- Article VI. This set of enforcement rules shall be implemented following approval of the college general meeting, the review of the University Faculty Evaluation Committee, and the authorization of the president. The same procedure shall be carried out when amendments are to be made.
