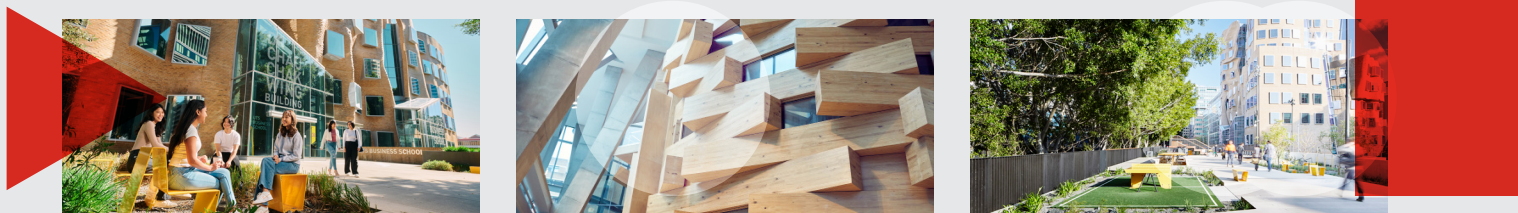
UTS Campus
